ORDER COMPELLING PRODUCTION OF DOCUMENTS

After considering Plaintiff's Motion to Compel Production of Documents,
the court GRANTS the motion and:

- Overrules Howard K. Stern's objections to Virgie Arthur's requests for production of documents;
- Orders Howard K. Stern to produce all documents responsive to the requests listed on the Subpoena Duces Tecum that was served upon Howard K. Stern prior to his deposition. Such documents shall be produced to Virgie Arthur's attorneys within ten (10) days of the entry of this order;
- Orders Howard K. Stern and his attorneys to certify in writing that they have made a good faith effort to locate and produce all responsive documents;
- Orders that Howard K. Stern's deposition resume and that any costs associated with the resumption of the deposition, including but not limited to attorneys fees, travel-related expenses for Plaintiff's counsel, and court reporting services, shall be paid by Defendant Howard K. Stern.

- Orders that Howard K. Stern answer questions posed to him in deposition regarding the nature of his relationship with Vickie Lynn Marshall, the nature of the decisions he made on behalf of Ms. Marshall, the work he performed for Ms. Marshall, and his testimony in Florida.
